Applying only to Brebner Primary School is not grounds for appeal.

*****PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING.*****

1) NO FAXES OR E-MAILS WILL BE ACCEPTED OR CONSIDERED.

- 2) Brebner Primary School can only admit a limited amount of grade 1 learners in 2023.
- 3) We can only admit learners in Grade 2 – 7 IF a present Brebner learner should leave, resulting in a vacancy.
- 4) All prospective learners and their parents must note that the parents of Brebner Primary School have decided that payment of school fees to Brebner Primary School is binding on all parents and all new parents thus also bind themselves to this decision and agree to any action that may be taken to collect contribution. (Registration for exemption from school fees is available in school office).
- 5) Parents must further note that this school is in the lowest subsidy bracket of the Department. Parents not living in the school's feeder area and who have financial constraints are advised to enquire about fees at their local schools.
- 6) All applications will be deemed as to have been received on 31 August 2022 and apply to 2023 applications only.
- 7) Learners without schools should be given preference. (If space is available at Brebner Primary School.
- 8) Please do not remove your child from his/her present school until you have written verification that your child has been accepted at Brebner Primary School.
- 9) Initial acceptances will be informed no later than 15 September 2022 Via SMS.
- 10) Unsuccessful applications will be placed on a numerical waiting list (A and B list).
- 11) It remains the responsibility of the parent to confirm whether or not their child has been accepted, but the school will send an sms or email as the postal service is unreliable.

BREBNER PRIMARY SCHOOL FEES 2023 (This is subject to change)

1.1. The proposed school fees are R1 200 per student per month for 10 months i.e. R12 000-00 per year. If the contribution is paid before the end of the first term, then R11 000-00 per year. Should the pupil for any reason leave the school during the course of the year discount will not be reimbursed and the outstanding amount will be calculated at R1200 per month. This will then be multiplied by the number of months the pupil attended school and subtracted from the amount paid. One months-paid notice will be mandatory.

1. 2. If there is more than one student in the direct (biological) family at Brebner Primary School, the contribution is R9 600-00 per year or R960 per month for each child. If contribution is paid before the end of the first term, then R9 100-00 per year for each child.

1.3. A stationery levy of R750 for all new pupils to cover notes and photocopying.

2. HOSTEL FEES ARE:

2.1 R9 900-00 per child per term (R39 600 per year) payable on arrival or within the first fourteen (14) days of each new term. If your application is successful you need to pay a deposit of R5 000 this deposit is NON-REFUNDABLE . If you pay monthly then it is R3 960 per month over 10 months.

- NB (A) No discount can be offered on Hostel fees.
(B) Four compulsory out-weekends per term included in costs.
(C) Does not include school fees.
(D) The R5000 deposit will be deducted from the last terms amount.

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NB. This is not an acceptance letter but merely serves as proof that your application has been received by the school.

1. The Department of Education has stipulated the following criteria for admissions and schools are bound by these regulations:

- 1.1 Proximity of primary schools and proximity of workplace of parent/s or home of parent/s:**
 It is recommended that learners whose parents live and work closest to the schools are prioritized. It is practical that a primary school that is situated closest to a particular secondary school is to be the feeder primary school of that secondary school. In other words feeder areas as defined in this letter.
- 1.2 Siblings already attending at the school. A sibling is defined as a learner who has a parent/s who is also the parent/s of another learner at the school, or if the learners reside in same household as another learner already attending at the school. Legal reasons and evidence must be supplied in this case e.g. Proof of Guardianship, Orphan, Foster care etc.**
- 1.3 A school may admit a fixed number of learners who may otherwise not be granted permission to the school, because these learners are boarders at the hostel attached to the school. Schools with boarding facilities are prohibited from admitting learners to boarding facilities without first granting learners admission to the school.**

SUMMARY OF ADMISSION POLICY – 2023

2. Admission Criteria

- 2.1. Learners from David Davidson (Brebner Pre-School) and the natural feeder area of the school must receive preference if; they meet the age criteria and there is a vacancy in the grade applied for and if they have handed in their application forms before the closing date. Admission to David Davidson for younger siblings does not guarantee admission for an older sibling to Brebner Primary School. Especially if older sibling already has a school.**
- 2.2 The natural feeder area for Brebner Primary School is: Bayswater, Waverley, Helicon Heights, Pentagon Park, Heuwelsig, Woodland Hills and the new development around Northridge Mall.**
- 2.3 If you work in the feeder area, please supply a letter from your employer confirming your employment. Letter to be on company letterhead.**
- 2.4 Hostel applications must be considered a priority.**

Proof of address must be in the form of either a utilities account, a lease agreement or proof of ownership (in the parent of the applicants name).

- 2.5. Learners from other areas are not entitled to admission but may be admitted if there is space. When admitting such learners the following criteria will be used:
 Hostel accommodation if the learner meets academic requirements.**

3. Please note!!

Applicable academic requirements will be determined by the average standard of the academic achievements of the applicants.

Unsuccessful applications will be placed on a waiting list.

Parents will be informed no later than 15 September 2022 if their application was successful via SMS.

If you do not receive any further correspondence please deem your application unsuccessful after this date.

4. Late applications

Late applications (after closing date) will be placed on list C, but can be considered on merit and preference will be given to:

4.1 Bona fida parents transferred to Bloemfontein after the closing date, who give proof of-

a) Residence in the feeder area

b) Appointment letter of parents in case of transfers if space is available.

4.2 If applicants (or parents or guardians) give any incorrect information or supply fraudulent documents, the application can be declared NULL AND VOID, even if the applicant has already been accepted.

4.3 Appeal process will close on Friday 22 September 2022 at 15h00. Forms available at school reception. Appeals can only be considered by the principal / appeals committee IF the school has made an error with regards to the following:

a) Sibling status

b) Home or work address

c) All other appeals must be submitted to Motheo District office.
